

Phil Stevens Presents at ISPO's 12th World Congress

Phil Stevens, M.Ed., CPO, was among the international presenters at the 12th World Congress of the International Society for Prosthetics and Orthotics (ISPO). The congress, considered the premiere global event for multidisciplinary prosthetic and orthotic care, was held in Vancouver, British Columbia, July 29-Aug. 3. The program provided sessions that addressed clinical, research, educational, industrial and innovative aspects of prosthetic and orthotic care.

Phil presentations included three papers he authored. They were:

- Using the Activities-Specific Balance Confidence Scale to Quantify the Impact of Prosthetic Knee Choice on Balance Confidence: a Case Study
- Pathophysiology of Muscular Dystrophy and Its Implications Upon Lower Extremity Orthotic Intervention: A Literature Review
- Postoperative Use of Remolding Orthoses Following Cranial Vault Remodeling: A Case Series

Phil also was the speaker at an instructional course, Clinical Foot Assessment Techniques, chaired by David Pratt, Ph.D., University of Birmingham, England.
